



A lush, green space tended to by an award-winning master gardener. Take one of the many wandering paths and discover over 200 varieties of hostas, interesting perennials, water features, and peaceful resting spots.

Fran Alexander

Using acrylics and oils, this artist creates work that captures just enough detail to evoke viewers' imaginations, exploring both the realistic and abstract in blossomed flowers and bird nests.

Chaka Chikodzi

Originally from Zimbabwe, Chaka learned the stone sculpting tradition from an older brother. He cites black experience as central to his expression, exploring stone as a nexus between geological time and human memory.

Connie O'Connor

Bright colours and bold brush strokes anchor this artist's work. Her subjects, often influenced by her Prairie roots, range from landscapes, to florals, to textural mixed media.

Gardener Rob Cousins

Bamboo, bonsai, and a beautiful pagoda-esque potting shed anchor this Asian-influenced garden. A well-planned space with pebble paths and hand-laid stonework show the care of this dedicated gardener.

Rob Cousins

An oil painter who takes inspiration from walks in the forests of North Vancouver, finding the contrast of leaves against the darker trees, and from marine scenes around Steveston.

Susanne Kestner-Aiello

A plein air painter who works with oil on canvas to explore and capture the Vancouver landscape. Her impressionistic style plays with light and shadow to convey a sense of place.

Douglas firs, old hedges, and rhododendrons hide away this secluded space. Featuring a large pond, an established rose garden, and working veggie beds, this garden is verdant and flourishing.

A city garden filled with plants rescued from local construction sites by a master gardener. Recently rescued plants include a 100 year old grape vine, fig tree, and winter jasmine, fitting in well with the old English feel of the space.

Aiden Fisher-Lang

This artist has a love of bright, colourful patterns, as the colours become happy to him when they are used together. He aims to make his audience feel more joyful about their lives through his work.

Veronica Roth

Known for her watercolour, ink, and chalk on ephemera, and for her large, expressive oils, this artist draws inspiration from her West Coast home in North Vancouver, and her Oxfordshire, UK home. Everything 'out there' is a state of possibility.

Gardener Christine Hood

Wander past the majestic magnolia tree and through the gate, and find a beautiful, eclectic country garden. Creatively repurposed outbuildings, veggie planters, and red brickwork all feature in this hideaway in the heart of the city.

Sandrine Pelissier

Hidden from the street by towering cedars, this smaller garden packs a big punch. Overflowing with perennials, veggies, and vines, the backyard is dominated by a rushing creek, and separated into intimate seating areas by hard landscaping.

Using light and colour as energetic components to stimulate the senses, this artist works in acrylics and transparent water colour mediums. She uses only nine colours and 'guest' hues in her palette, bringing a light from within.


Gardener Lawrence Wick

Join this exotic plant specialist and bonsai artist on a botanical trip around the world. This eclectic garden features plants, statues, and trinkets from the gardener's extensive travels, anchored by stonework and a flowing creek.

This artisan creates simple, decorative, but above all functional, leather handbags from found, upcycled leather. He also hand-carves walking staffs and canes from a variety of West Coast woods.

An extremely knowledgeable gardener oversees a collection of interesting plants, shrubs, and trees. The space features a brand new backyard potager garden with laid paving stones and flowers interspersed around the veggies and herbs.

Returning to photography in retirement, this artist desires to capture everything she sees. She is particularly attracted to people being busy with their everyday lives, as seen in her *From India* series.

A textile and acrylic artist who lately enjoys creating abstracts and 'wild faces'. She paints people and impressionistic landscapes – all done with bursts of colour, experimentation, and happy accidents.

A painter who works in acrylics and loves to play with colour and light. She uses a palette knife to create highly textured, impressionistic landscapes that emit joy and the vital energy of the world's beauty.

This carefully laid out garden mixes West Coast and European influences, and uses masses of found rocks and recycled construction materials to give structure and shape to the garden beds, retaining walls, and decks. Established trees, perennials, and shrubs surround a rocky pond and waterfall.

Grazyna Wolski

Large-scale floral paintings using bold, bright colors illustrate this artist's deep emotional connection with flowers. Her creative process, like nature, is forever developing, unpredictable, and miraculous.

A modern garden featuring expertly laid hard landscaping, decks, and seating areas. Boxwood hedges and West Coast perennials provide structure and organization to the garden beds, while palms, flowering annuals, and views of the inlet provide interest.

Michael Binkley

This artist carves stone sculptures which please the eye and touch the soul. He strives to reconnect individuals to their primal instinct of touch, paying as much attention to the finishing of the piece as to the design.

Tary Majidi

This artist truly embodies the meaning of an international artist, having lived on many different continents before settling in West Vancouver. She works in both acrylic and patinated terracotta.

Polina Skvortsova

Striving to capture the atmosphere, light, and colours natural to Vancouver, this artist is particularly interested in the ability of texture to add a tactile element to the visual experience of mixed media painting.

Heavily influenced by the North Shore forests and the man-made structures and outline shapes of Vancouver, this artist uses vibrant colours, acrylic, and mixed media to express the silhouettes she sees.

Guy Hollington

For this artist, glass is a medium that incorporates both preplanning and spontaneity. He wants his finished pieces to become part of everyday living, to be both ornamental and practical.

Sheree Jones

This artist loves colour, the texture of fabrics, and shifting light in a landscape, all providing inspiration for her canvases. She leads workshops in her studio and plein air adventures throughout BC.

2820 Marine Drive, West Vancouver

Gardeners Sue & Hugh Fraser

A rare, expansive heritage location backing on to the railroad. The cottage is surrounded by large, flowering shrubs, perennials, a veggie garden, fruit trees, a pond, and chickens. Anchored by a outdoor brick oven, which served the soldiers during World War II.

Gordon Davis

The theme of this artist's work is always 'happiness reigns'. Most of his work is plein air landscapes and flowers, verging on the side of expressionism, pushing a little away from reality.

STAGES of Creativity

This organization brings together people with disabilities to create art as one artist. Everyone has a role to play, and without everyone, their art would not exist. STAGES will be exhibiting hand built birdhouses.

Jeff Wilson

This artist works with acrylic to produce images in a realist style, combining a vibrant palette and asymmetric compositions to depict the dignity and intensity of the real world.

Barry Shelton

Energetic textural ground gives way to acrylic on canvas paintings of metaphorical, abstracted nature in a unified simplicity of symbol and light, colour, and design.

Monica Shelton

A lifetime visual artist, utilizing playful and enigmatic images in acrylic on canvas. The natural world is interpreted in colour vibrations that allow for freedom, wholeness, and surprise.


