North Van Arts (North Vancouver Community Arts Council) is currently accepting submissions for our Art in the Community Programme for **January 2023 - June 2023**. Currently this exhibition programme takes place at one venue:

• District Library Gallery / Located at in the Lynn Valley Main Library

The Art in the Community Programme, run by North Van Arts and has a mandate to celebrate and enable emerging and professional artists through offering an exhibition in a public space, which serves to promote artists, to increase public awareness of the visual arts, and to make original work by local artists accessible to the public.

We invite visual artists working in all 2D mediums including painting, photography, and mixed media. Successful candidates will be booked for an eight-to-twelve-week exhibition.

North Van Arts will manage digital marketing materials, exhibition installation, sales, and the promotion of the exhibition through our website, member newsletters, e-bulletins, press releases and online listings.

North Van Arts encourages applicants of all races, ethnicities, identities, abilities, ages, and genders, to apply.

Key information for applications:

- North Van Arts staff handle all sales. North Van Arts takes a 30% commission on sales of artwork.
- This call is for District Library Gallery, located at in the Lynn Valley Main Library.

All Exhibition Proposals must include the following:

- An artist's statement and biography
- List of works including title, date, medium, size, and price. If the work is not for sale, a value is still necessary.
- Attach up to 10 high-res images (no more the 1MB each) of works that you would like
 to propose for an exhibition. Proposed artwork must be available for the exhibition at
 the time of making the application. Images must be titled to match the corresponding
 list of works. If work is framed, please include image of the frame.
- Artwork should not have been displayed on the North Shore within a one year prior to the application.

- Proposed artwork must be representative of a collection of work and have a cohesive concept/theme/or subject matter. Any framed work proposed should be framed professionally.
- All artwork must be fixed with two eyehooks, D-rings, eyelets or their equivalent, on the back of the frame or canvas. The 2D pieces are hung with a track system that uses construction string threaded through the eyelet hole. Important eyelets need to be installed approximately 1-2 inches from the top of the work piece.
