WHAT DOES NORTH VAN ARTS OFFER YOU, THE ARTIST?

- A professional, curated and installed show in a unique exhibition space
- Professionally designed promotional material
- An Opening Reception (dependent on PHO)
- Promotion of the exhibition through regular ebulletin newsletters, press releases to local media and regional galleries, posters and printed invites
- An online presence on the North Van Arts website and social media channels
- Invitations sent to local councilors and VIPs for the Opening Reception
- Coordination of the sale of artwork (30% commission to gallery)

Proposal Overview

- CityScape Community ArtSpace only exhibits group exhibitions
- Proposals submitted should be for 3 artists or more, if you have a concept we could also do an open call to bring in more artists
- Exhibition proposals should be well researched and outline a clear concept
- Consider themes that you believe should be at the forefront of life today, either locally, nationally, or internationally. For example, climate change, the natural world, inclusivity, confronting social norms, and innovation
- At this time, there are no fees to exhibit but artists are welcome to sell their work. North Van Arts takes a 30% commission
- Exhibitions are selected by a jury

Mother Tongue

February 26 - April 24, 2021

Artists Sara Khan, Laura Rosengren, and Katherine Duclos address the complex range of emotions and practices inherent in the life-changing transformation motherhood brings. This exhibition draws together multiple mothers' narratives by creating a visual language of their experiences, challenging the idealized preconceived notions of motherhood.

DIFFERENT WAYS TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL:

- As a group of artists with a theme
- As an artist with a theme: North Van Arts can put out a call to artists or invite more artist to 'complete the exhibition'.
- As a community member with a theme: North Van Arts can put out a call to artists or invite more artist to 'complete the exhibition'

Exhibition Proposals should include...

- A 1-pager clearly outlining the theme and concept of the proposed exhibition
- A title (this can be a working title)
- Details of the proposed artwork and how it relates to the theme.
- Contact details of all the artists and the main contact for the artist group.
- A plan, and budget outline for an *Interactive Component* (a talk, workshop or demonstration) that will take place during the exhibition.

Exhibition Proposals should include...

- Artist info: Tell us about your professional experience, past exhibitions and schooling
 - Include your cv, biography, and artist statement

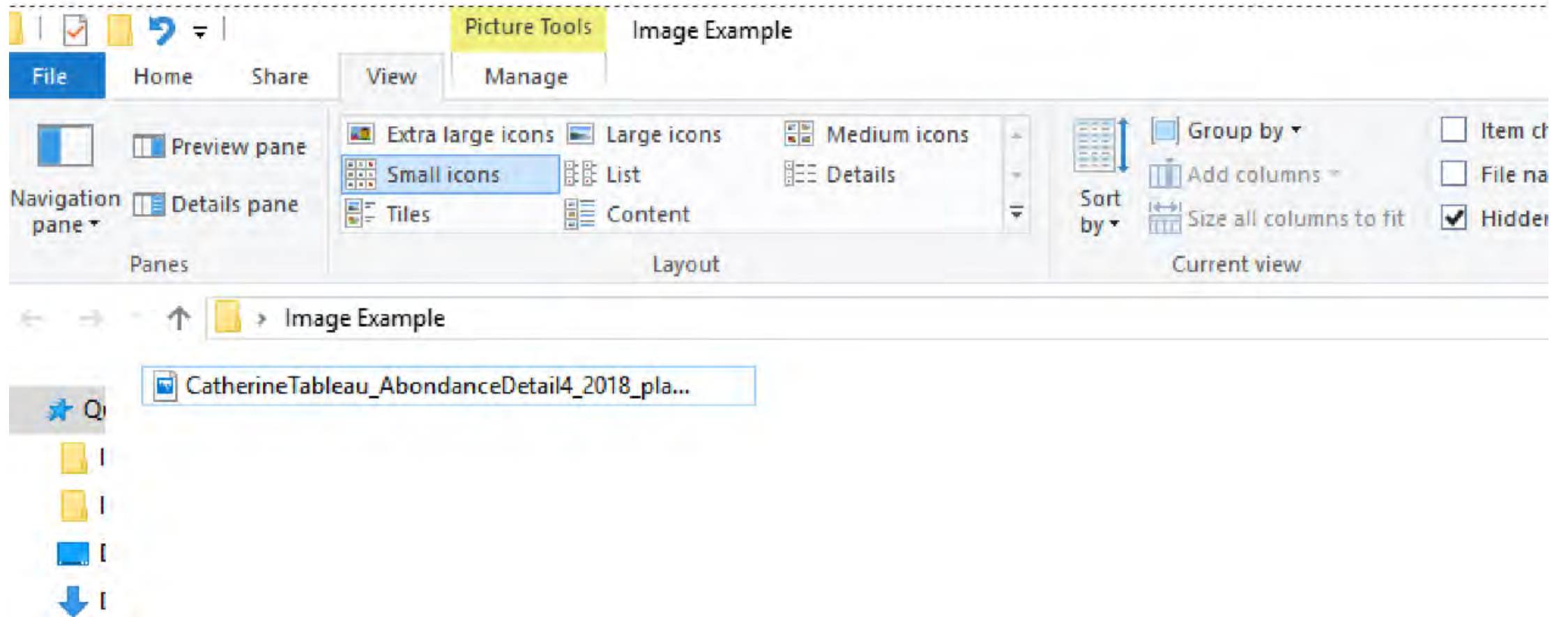
IMAGES

- Images are often used for promotion, they should be clear and ready to use for print.
- Please provide 8 to 10 images
- Images should be high-resolution (1MB)
- All images should be attached as JPEGs
- Make sure that each JPEG is titled with the artist's name, title, year, medium:
 - IndividualArtistName_WorkTitle_Date_Medium_Dimensions.jpg
 - NOTE: standard dimensions are height x width x depth

- All of the work you would like to submit for exhibition
- Thumbnail images of each piece
- Details of the piece next to each thumbnail, this should include:
 - Artist name, work title, medium, date, and price
