CLUE 1:

ON THE SIDE OF THE AQUATIC CENTRE IS AN INSTALLATION CALLED 'AQUASCAPES' MADE O' SUNSHADES THAT MOVE DEPENDING ON THE WEATHER CONDITIONS! CAN YOU FIND THE NAME OF THE ARTIST? THE FIRST LETTER O' HER NAME IS YER FIRST CLUE!

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CLUE 2:

WEST VANCOUVER MEMORIAL LIBRARY BE FOUNDED IN 1950 AS A MEMORIAL TO HONOUR THOSE WHO FOUGHT IN WHICH WORLD WAR? SPELL OUT THE NUMBER AND TAKE THE SECOND LETTER.

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CLUE 3:

TH' WEST VANCOUVER ART MUSEUM HIGHLIGHTS IMPORTANT CREATORS, INNOVATORS 'N SIGNIFICANT EVENTS THAT SHAPE OUR COMMUNITY, REGION 'N COUNTRY THROUGH IT'S PROGRAMS N' EXHIBITIONS. TO THE WEST OF THE MAIN ENTRANCE! THERE WAITS A CLUE.

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CLUE 4:

WE LOVE US SOME TREASURE BUT THIS PIECE O' JADE IS TOO HEAVY. THIS PIECE WAS CARVED FROM A 12 TONNE BOULDER FROM TH' CASSIAR DISTRICT O' NORTHERN BC. WHAT BE THE FIFTH LETTER ALONG ON THE SMALL PLAQUE?

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CLUE 5:

THESE SCULPTURES BE FACING OUT TO SEA JUST LIKE US PIRATES LIKE TO DO! WHAT ARE THE CHAIRS MADE OF? TAKE THE FIRST LETTER O' THAT MATERIAL AND THERE YE HAVE IT.

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CLUE 6:

THIS STAINLESS STEEL SCULPTURE FEATURES 13 SALMON! DO YOU KNOW WHICH TYPE OF SALMON? WHICH VOWEL IS IN THAT WORD? YOU'RE GETTING CLOSER TO YER TREASURE!

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CLUE 7:

THE SILK PURSE WAS ORIGINALLY A SUMMER COTTAGE BUILT IN TH' 1920'S, REFLECTIN' TH' PREDOMINANT USE O' LAND ALONG TH' AMBLESIDE SHORE AFORE TH' CONSTRUCTION O' TH' LIONS GATE BRIDGE. IT NOW BE AN ARTS CENTRE. WHAT WAS THE LAST NAME OF THE OWNER WHO RENTED IT AS A 'HONEYMOON COTTAGE? TAKE THE LAST LETTER OF THAT NAME.

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CLUE 8:

THIS SCULPTURE ECHOES THE SHAPE OF THE LIONS GATE BRIDGE. BETWEEN TH' PADDLES BE A COAST SALISH IMAGE O' A THUNDERBIRD HEAD. IN TH' BACKGROUND BE A CANOE WIT' TWO PADDLES TO SIGNIFY WEST VANCOUVER AND THE SQUAMISH NATION WORKING TOGETHER AND SHARING MUTUAL RESPECT. WHAT DOES THE ARTIST'S FIRST NAME BEGIN WITH? (LOOK INSIDE THE BRACKETS).
