

## **VOLUNTEER POSTING: EVENT ASSISTANT**

This role requires working shifts in a standing position with some heavy lifting, and is best suited to those who can multitask, love to network and have a passion for the arts. Shifts are mostly worked with other volunteers and staff members as a close-knit team. Regular events include Opening Receptions, Date Nights (workshops), and Artist Mixers.

If you have a passion for the arts, an energetic demeanor, and willingness to learn about the breadth of North Van Arts services we invite to join us.

## Main Duties include:

- Setup / Clean up of event area (tables, chairs, art supplies etc.)
- Greeting guests and recording guest count
- Assisting Staff/ Instructors with additional tasks

The Events Assistant role is available throughout the year, at opening receptions, date nights and other CityScape events as needed. We ask that Events Assistants commits to a minimum of 1 shift (2-4hrs)
