Volunteer Bartenders work best in a busy, social environment and enjoy interacting with event guests and artists. This role requires working shifts in a standing position with some heavy lifting, and is best suited to those who can multitask, love to network and have experience in a bar environment. Shifts are mostly worked with other volunteers and staff members as a close-knit team.

If you have a passion for the arts, an energetic demeanor, and willingness to learn about the breadth of North Van Arts services we invite to join us.

Main Duties include:

- Setup / Clean up of the bar service area
- Knowledge of liquor license and serving laws
- Cash handling and operating point of sales
- Serving liquor within regulations
- Clean up of glassware

The Volunteer Bartender role is available throughout the year, at opening receptions, Date Nights and other CityScape events as needed. We ask that volunteer bartenders commit to a minimum of 3 shifts (6-12 hrs). All volunteer bartenders must have a valid Serving It Right certificate completed and be over the age of 19.

Local community members of all backgrounds are invited to volunteer in this role.
