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EXHIBITIONS | CityScape Community ArtSpace

North Van Arts has operated this City-owned facility since 2001, featuring group-based, themed exhibitions. The mission of CityScape Community ArtSpace is to celebrate and promote art and artists through quality experiences in a unique and inviting gallery space, and to create an inclusive environment which enriches and encourages interaction in the community.

Nostalgia For The Future

July 4 – August 17, 2024

Nostalgia For the Future explored the intersection between technology and humanity, and the concept of Retrofuturism – the way people once envisioned the future.

Art Rental Show

August 23 – September 21, 2024

Art Rental Show, a semi-annual exhibition, displayed work from talented local artists in our Art Rental collection. Artworks could be rented or purchased.

Tactile Memories

September 27 – November 9, 2024

Tactile Memories was a multi-medium show of large-scale sewing and rug tufting pieces by Emily Kirsch, Angie Marchinkow, and Nicole Young that explored the theme of pursuits guided by interest, rather than expectation.

Anonymous Art Show

November 28 – December 15, 2024

The 21st annual fundraiser, *Anonymous Art Show*, displayed original artworks on 8" x 8" canvases from emerging and established local artists. All priced at \$100, the artists receive 50% of the sale.

Clean Slate

January 17 – March 1, 2025

Clean Slate was a group exhibition that explored both the challenges and opportunities that arise when one is faced with a blank canvas.

Art Rental Show

March 8 – April 19, 2025

The *Art Rental Show* showcased new artworks added to the Art Rental program. Visitors could rent or buy their favourite pieces right off the wall.

Mosaic Revival: Three Contemporary Expressions

May 2 – June 6, 2025

Mosaic Revival highlighted three distinct voices of mosaic artists Daryl Wood, Lilian Broca, and Maria Abagis, whose works reimagined the complexity and versatility of this ancient medium and its role in contemporary society.

Through the Garden Gates

June 14 – July 18, 2025

Through the Garden Gates was the sister exhibition to Arts in the Garden. This exhibition transformed CityScape into a vibrant community art garden with a mix of 2D and 3D artwork inspired by domestic floral and botanical themes.

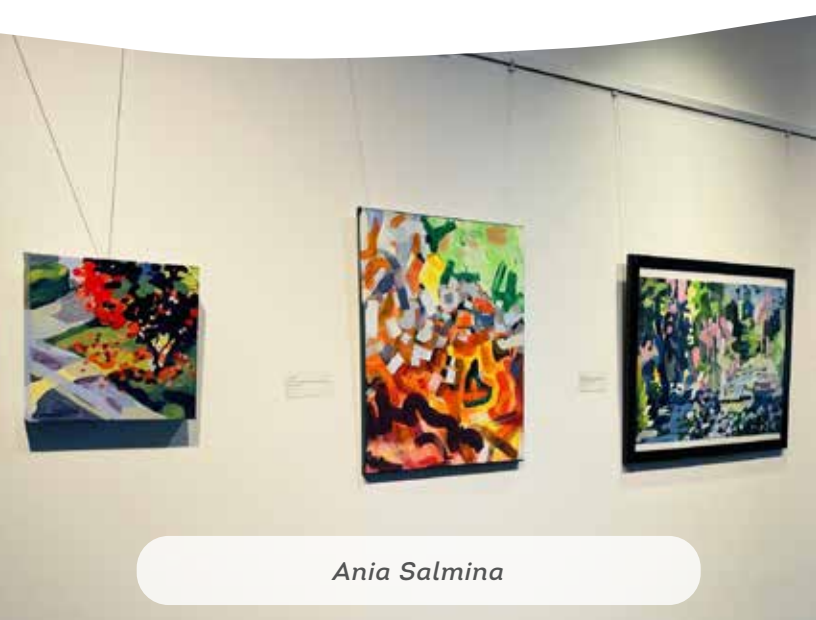

ART RENTAL

The Art Rental program promotes the appreciation of 2D visual arts in our community by making the work of local artists available for display in homes, offices, and film and television production sets.

The collection features 410 original works by 165 artists in a wide variety of styles and subjects. Artworks for rent and sale include paintings, photography, and mixed media with pieces ranging in size from 8" x 10" to 48" x 48".

Established in 1972, the collection is kept fresh with new works added in each year through an adjudication process. The artworks are viewable online and are displayed in the Art Rental Salon in the back of the CityScape gallery where they are available to visitors year-round. Highlights were showcased in two salon-style exhibitions over the year at CityScape Community ArtSpace.

ANONYMOUS ART SHOW

NOVEMBER 28 - DECEMBER 15, 2024

On November 28, 2024 North Van Arts opened live sales for the 21st edition of our annual fundraising event, the *Anonymous Art Show*. This group exhibition and fundraising event received hundreds of submissions from both established and emerging artists. All the artwork on display was 8" x 8" in size and was sold anonymously for \$100.

Participating artists received 50% of the profits, with the other 50% going towards North Van Arts, to support many of our valuable programs including free community events, art classes and exhibitions.

ART & MYCOLOGY

Art & Mycology is an arts-based experience based at Mountainside Secondary, which promotes health and well-being to at-risk-youth (13-18 years) through the exploration of fungi and the arts. The program aims to increase self-esteem; create positive connections between peers; inspire an interest in ecology through art; and develop empathy towards the natural environment and other people.

This year, 6 years since the programming began, art therapists led guided outdoor art activities inspired by ecology and fungal life, for 40 students, once a week between September and June for the school term.

RHYTHM & WORD

Rhythm & Word Music Therapy is a community-based creative program for at-risk youth (13-18 years) which has operated at Mountainside Secondary School since 2012. Facilitated by an accredited Music Therapist, the program provides opportunities to strengthen students academically, emotionally, and socially by utilizing music to promote their well-being. Students can choose to learn the guitar, vocals, rap, and songwriting individually or in a group.

The program ran 3 days a week between September and June for the school term, engaging 40 students with great success.



ARTS IN THE GARDEN

ARTS IN THE GARDEN 2025

JUNE 14 & 15, 2025

Arts in the Garden returned for the final 26th edition in 2025. The event was held on June 14 & 15, with the goal of bringing community members together to celebrate visual art, performance, and music across 10 beautiful outdoor spaces on the North Shore.

This annual event saw roughly 2900 garden visits across 10 locations, and showcased 70 talented musicians, artists and performers throughout the weekend.

NORTH SHORE ART CRAWL

OCTOBER 4 - 6, 2024

From October 4-6, North Van Arts hosted the 14th annual North Shore Art Crawl.

This annual 3-day arts festival offered art enthusiasts an insider's look into the vibrant North Shore arts scene by interacting with artists and artisans who work with a variety of mediums including textiles, jewelry, pottery, graphic design, sculpture, painting, glass, and photography. With opening receptions, art practice demonstrations and open studio tours across North Vancouver and West Vancouver, this community event engaged over 7,000 visitors this year and continues to be a legacy event for the organization.

North Shore Art Crawl Artist Mixer

For the first time ever, North Van Arts also hosted an Artist Mixer on October 4 at CityScape Community ArtSpace. The mixer attracted 65 artists and allowed them the opportunity to connect with the arts community and meet other participants.



NORTH SHORE CULTURE COMPASS



Launched in March 2020, this free online map visualizes cultural offerings on Vancouver's North Shore. The web-based mapping tool is a participatory culture map for and by the community, with new listings and events added all the time, and partnerships within and beyond the cultural sector. This year, we received funding to allocate towards improving our website design to create a new page for the Culture Quest app, create a splash screen, and improve user interface. The upgrades to our website were created in conjunction with ESRI Canada.

In 2024-2025, the Culture Compass expanded to host more than 1500 events and cultural assets.

NORTH SHORE CULTURE QUEST

With funding from the BC Destination Development Fund, this year North Van Arts converted content from the North Shore Culture Compass website to the North Shore Culture Quest, an easy-to-use app that North Van Arts officially launched in May. The App releases new quests each month, designed to encourage app users to explore different areas of the North Shore and explore the region's culture, history and art by turning it into an interactive scavenger hunt game. The app was designed in conjunction with On This Spot, a company led by Andrew Farris and Christopher Reid, two North Shore residents, with content developed primarily by Harriet Goodwin.



SINCE TIME IMMEMORIAL EXHIBITION

Since Time Immemorial is an exhibition on display at the Lynn Valley Library sharing *Sk̓wx̓wú7mesh* Stories, Art, Animals, and Placenames as seen on the North Shore Culture Compass. This exhibition brings points from the map to life, with artwork, audio, and storytelling. This exhibition featured artwork by *Tsitsayxemaat* Rebecca Duncan, *Xàlek'/Sek'yú* Siyám Chief Ian Campbell, and Chamiya Janis Campbell from *Sk̓wx̓wú7mesh* (Squamish) Nation, and Olivia George from *səlilwətaɬ* (Tsleil-Waututh) Nation. Additionally, three Storytelling sessions with *Tsitsayxemaat* Rebecca Duncan were hosted at the library.



FUNDRAISING

North Van Arts published its 8th You Are Here Calendar for 2025. An annual fundraiser for the Culture Compass, the You Are Here Calendar featured images of the North Shore created by local artists. This year, the 12 artworks were selected, which were featured in three exhibitions at The District Library Gallery, Lynn Valley Library, and the Silk Purse Arts Centre in West Vancouver.

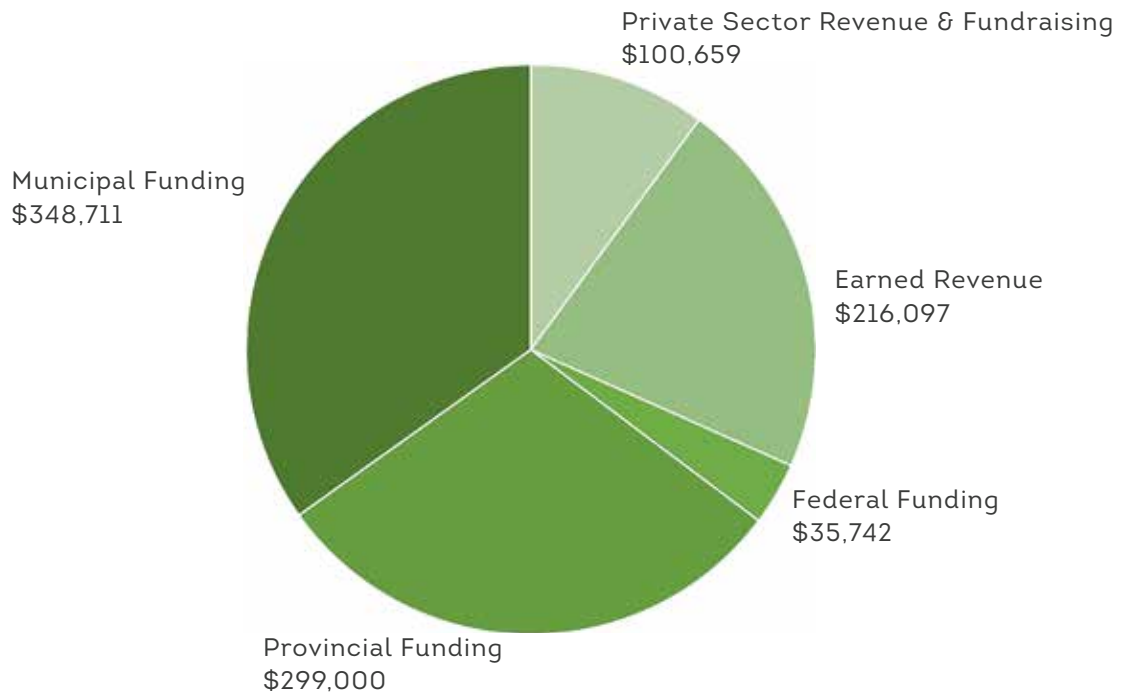

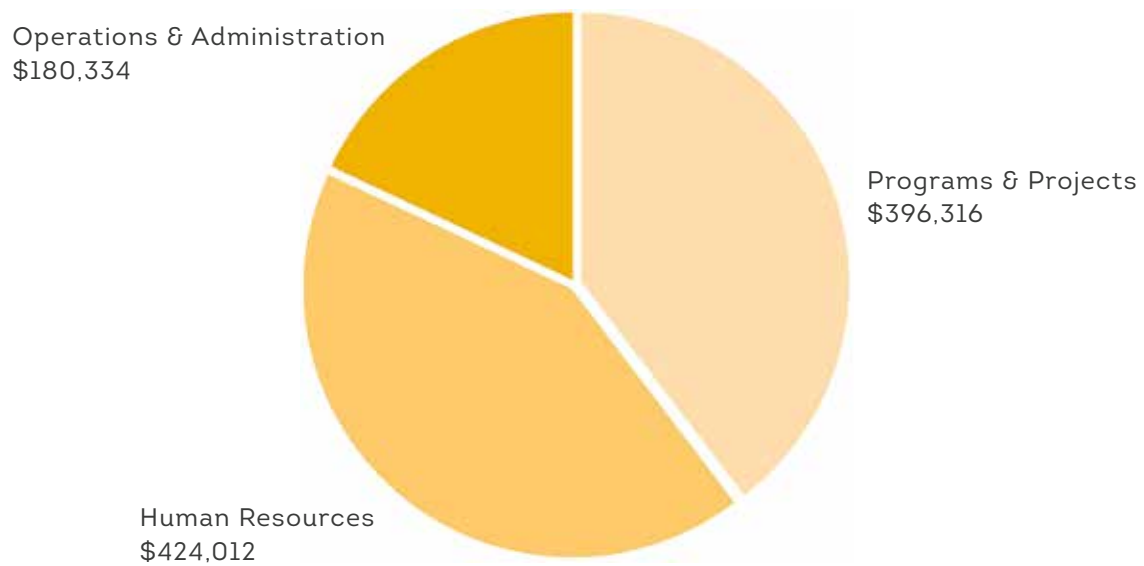
