## Call for Festival Volunteers

### Trolley Days: Heritage in Motion

North Van Arts is seeking friendly and community-minded volunteers to help bring [Trolley Days: Heritage in Motion](#) to life! Trolley Days is a brand-new outdoor performing arts festival celebrating the rich and diverse history of the North Shore.

Taking place at Shipyards (Shipbuilders' Square) in North Vancouver on Saturday, June 6 and Sunday, June 7, 2026, this free, family-friendly festival will feature live music and performances, local and Indigenous artists, family craft activities, and heritage-style trolley tours.

- **Date:** Saturday & Sunday, June 6th & 7th, 2026
- **Shift duration:** 3.5 hour shifts
- **Location:** Shipyards , North Vancouver
- **Shifts available:** 44
- **Age:** volunteers should be 15+

We have five volunteer positions available:

### **1. Trolley Attendant**

Working alongside a member of staff:

- Assists with ticket scanning/guest check in
- Provide guest info & wayfinding for main festival
- Option to be seated or standing

*Daily shifts:* 10:30 AM to 2:00 PM - 2:00 PM to 5:30 PM

### **2. Info Tent Attendant**

Working alongside a member of staff

- Assists with festival information, wayfinding etc
- Provide general information about North Van Arts
- Provide information about the Culture Compass/ and Culture Quest App
- Support Merchandise sales
- Option to be seated or standing
- First Aid Certificate an asset (not required)

*Daily shifts:* 10:30 AM to 2:00 PM - 2:00 PM to 5:30 PM

### **3. Arts & Craft Tent Attendant**

Working alongside a member of staff

- Assists parents and children with completing craft activity
- Replenish craft supplies/ clean craft stations as needed
- Monitor capacity (assist with queue if needed)
- Must be energetic and enjoy working with children/families

*Daily shifts:* 10:30 AM to 2:00 PM - 2:00 PM to 5:30 PM

### **4. WayFinding Assistant**

- Assists guests with wayfinding
- Manage crowd pinch points, keep pathways clear etc.

- Monitor onsite crowd movement, safety
- Support staff with additional tasks as needed

*Daily shifts:* 10:30 AM to 2:00 PM - 2:00 PM to 5:30 PM

### **5. Setup/ Tear Down Assistant**

- Assist staff with venue set up/ tear down
- Lift and install of tents, tables and chairs
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs

*Daily shifts:* 8:00 am to 11:30 am - 4:30 pm to 8:00 pm
